2. Contest will be held at the Old Settlers Park Pavilion

Pepper Eating Contest Rules

1. The contest will run for 30 minutes.
2. All contestants must be signed in and seated at the competition table 5 minutes prior to the start of the contest.
3. Contestants may not leave the defined contest area until the winner is announced.
4. Contestants must eat all of the pepper for it to be counted as "eaten". A pepper is considered "eaten" when its flesh, seeds and juices have been ingested and swallowed by the contestant.
5. A pepper with more than one quarter of an inch of flesh remaining on its stem will not be counted as "eaten".
6. Contestants may not squeeze the pepper in an attempt to remove the pepper's juices or seeds.
7. Contestants may not eat anything but the peppers during the contest.
8. Contestants may drink water, but other fluids are not allowed during the contest.
9. If you throw up, you will be disqualified. The peppers must stay down in order to count. You can continue but you will start over at 1.

The undersigned agrees that the July 4th & Frontier Days Celebration may use pictures and slides submitted for publicizing the event.
