## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids addressed to Eddie Zapata, Project Manager, City of Round Rock Utilities and Environmental Services, 221 East Main Street, Round Rock, TX 78664, for furnishing all labor, material and equipment and performing all work required for the project titled Lake Creek 2 & Lake Creek 3 Wastewater Line Upgrades (project includes replacement of approximately 4,900 L.F. of existing Lake Creek 2 wastewater line and replacement of approximately 1,300 L.F. of existing Lake Creek 3 wastewater line) will be received until **2:00 p.m. on June 25, 2015** then publicly opened and read aloud in Council Chambers located at 221 East Main Street, Round Rock, TX 78664. Bid envelopes shall state date and time of bid and "**Lake Creek 2 & 3 Wastewater Line Upgrades**". Bids must also be accompanied by a "Statement of Bidder's Safety Experience" included in Section 410 of the Project Manual. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled opening time. Any bids received after scheduled bid opening time will be returned unopened.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 p.m. on June 11, 2015 at 221 East Main Street, Round Rock, TX 78664.

Bids must be submitted on City of Round Rock bid forms and must be accompanied by an acceptable bid security as outlined in the Instructions to Bidders, payable to the City of Round Rock, Texas equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid amount. Plans, Bid Forms, Specifications, and Instructions to Bidders may be obtained from Document Engine, Inc. located at 700 Jeffrey Way, Suite 200, Round Rock, TX 78665, telephone number (512) 310-8228, for a non-refundable charge of \$150.00 per set.

In case of ambiguity, duplication, or obscurity in the bids, the City of Round Rock reserves the right to construe the meaning thereof. The City of Round Rock further reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities and irregularities in the bids received.

The successful bidder will be expected to execute the City of Round Rock's standard contract and to furnish performance and payment bonds, all as described in the bid documents. Contractors and subcontractors shall pay to laborers, workmen, and mechanics the prevailing wage rates as determined by the City of Round Rock.
