BOIL WATER NOTICE

Effective July 23, 2015

Due to a line break the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system, Manville Water Supply Corp. – PWS # 2270033, to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, Manville WSC will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
