Nomination Process

To nominate a neighborhood for the award, please send a short description (1,000 words maximum) of why you believe that neighborhood exemplifies the qualities of Neighborhood of the Year by answering the following questions:

- Describe your neighborhood group. When it was established? How many residents participate?
- Describe the projects, activities or events for which you are nominating this association
- What were the results?
- Please include anything else that you believe would help best show the achievements, especially any digital photos

All applications must contain the contact information of the neighborhood being nominated to include: name, address, email address and phone number to the best of your ability. For clarification purposes the judges may need to contact you, please include your contact information as well.

All applications will be kept confidential and shall be reviewed by a panel of anonymous judges. If submitting by email, send it to jbrehm@roundrocktexas.gov
