Past examples include an the Forest Creek HOA recycled water connection project and the Greater Round Rock West and Mesa Ridge's address curb painting project.

## **Nomination Process**

To nominate a neighborhood for the award, please send a short description (1,000 words maximum) of why you believe that neighborhood exemplifies the qualities of Project of the Year by answering the following questions:

- Describe the project for which you are nominating this association
- What were the results?
- How has the project benefited the neighborhood?
- Please include anything else that you believe would help best show the achievements, especially any digital photos

All applications must contain the contact information of the neighborhood being nominated to include: name, address, email address and phone number to the best of your ability. For clarification purposes the judges may need to contact you, please include your contact information as well.
