Rental Rates and Regulations

*All rental fees are due at the time of reservation.

*Both plazas are available for rental between the hours of 8 am-12 am.

Sharon Prete Main Street Plaza

Deposit: \$100 refundable damage/cleaning deposit

Private—4 Hour Minimum Fee \$300 and \$75 per each additional hour and plaza is closed to the public for a private event

Public—2 Hour Minimum Fee \$100 and \$50 per each additional hour and plaza remains open to the public

Extras:

Custom Light Programs: \$25/hour

Electrical Hookups: 110 outlet/\$15 per day; 220 outlet/\$25 per day to be determined on as needed basis

Potable Water Hookups: \$25/per day for Concession use only along city buildings

Centennial Plaza

Deposit: \$200 refundable damage/cleaning deposit

Private—4 Hour Minimum Fee \$400 and \$100 per each additional hour and plaza is closed to the public for a private event.

Public—2 Hour Minimum Fee \$150 and \$75 per each additional hour and plaza remains open to the public.

Extras:

Electrical Hookups: 110 outlet/\$15 per day; 220 outlet/ \$25 per day to be determined on as needed basis.

Potable Water Hookups: \$25 per day for concession use only along city buildings.
