THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK OFFERS RESIDENTS ANNUAL CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING SERVICES AT THE ROUND ROCK BRUSH RECYCLING CENTER

ROUND ROCK, TEXAS - The City of Round Rock encourages residents to recycle their Christmas trees on **Saturday, December 31, 2016** and **Saturday, January 7, 2017** from **9am to 6pm** at the Round Rock Brush Recycling Center located at 310 Deepwood Drive. The City will give away 100 small tree seedlings (one per vehicle/first come, first serve) on these dates. **Additionally, residents may bring their Christmas trees for recycling to the Round Rock Brush Recycling Center during any regular operating day.**

Residents must remove all decorations, nails, wires, ornaments, tree stands, lights, and tinsel before bringing in their tree to the recycling center. The trees will be shredded into a fine, usable mulch which is free to Round Rock residents for pickup at the recycling center. The mulch can also be purchased by contractors and non-residents for \$5 per cubic yard with a 2 cubic yard minimum. The center is open from Monday – Saturday from 9:00am to 6:00pm. The center is closed on Sundays.

Local businesses can also drop off their Christmas trees, and for a small fee (\$15 per truckload), businesses that sell Christmas trees can recycle their leftovers as well. For more information, contact the city of Round Rock Forestry Manager Emsud Horozovic at (512) 341-3350.
