



Basic Rules for Visitors:

- 1) Park hours are from 6:00am to 12:00am (midnight). No one is permitted in the park after midnight.
- 2) We are very proud of the great job the park staff does to make the park beautiful. We ask you to please operate your vehicles on paved portions of the park and do not park on any grass area unless it is designated as an additional parking area. Parking in non-designated areas could result in a fine.
- 3) We do not allow camping in any public area. Including parks in the City of Round Rock. If you wish to camp please make arrangements at a location outside the park before arriving for your visit.
- 4) No alcohol is allowed at any organized sporting event where the participants are of non-drinking age. When in doubt, pour it out.
- 5) We love dogs at our Parks, but not at any organized sporting events. If you must bring your dog, they cannot be within 100 feet of any of the fields or field entrances and must be on a leash less than 25' long. We will not be responsible for you having to watch from a hilltop because Fido came along.

Additional Park Rules for Sports Fields and Complexes:

- SFC 1) Smoking is prohibited.
- SFC 2) No unauthorized vehicles will be allowed on Sports Fields or inside Complexes including, but not limited to, ATV's, bicycles, scooters, inline skates.
- SFC 3) Parking along any section of Harrell Parkway, Aten Loop or T.C. Oatts Drive is prohibited.
- SFC 4) Disruptive behavior, interference with officials and abusive behavior are grounds for removal from the premises.
- SFC 5) No unauthorized personal training instruction.
