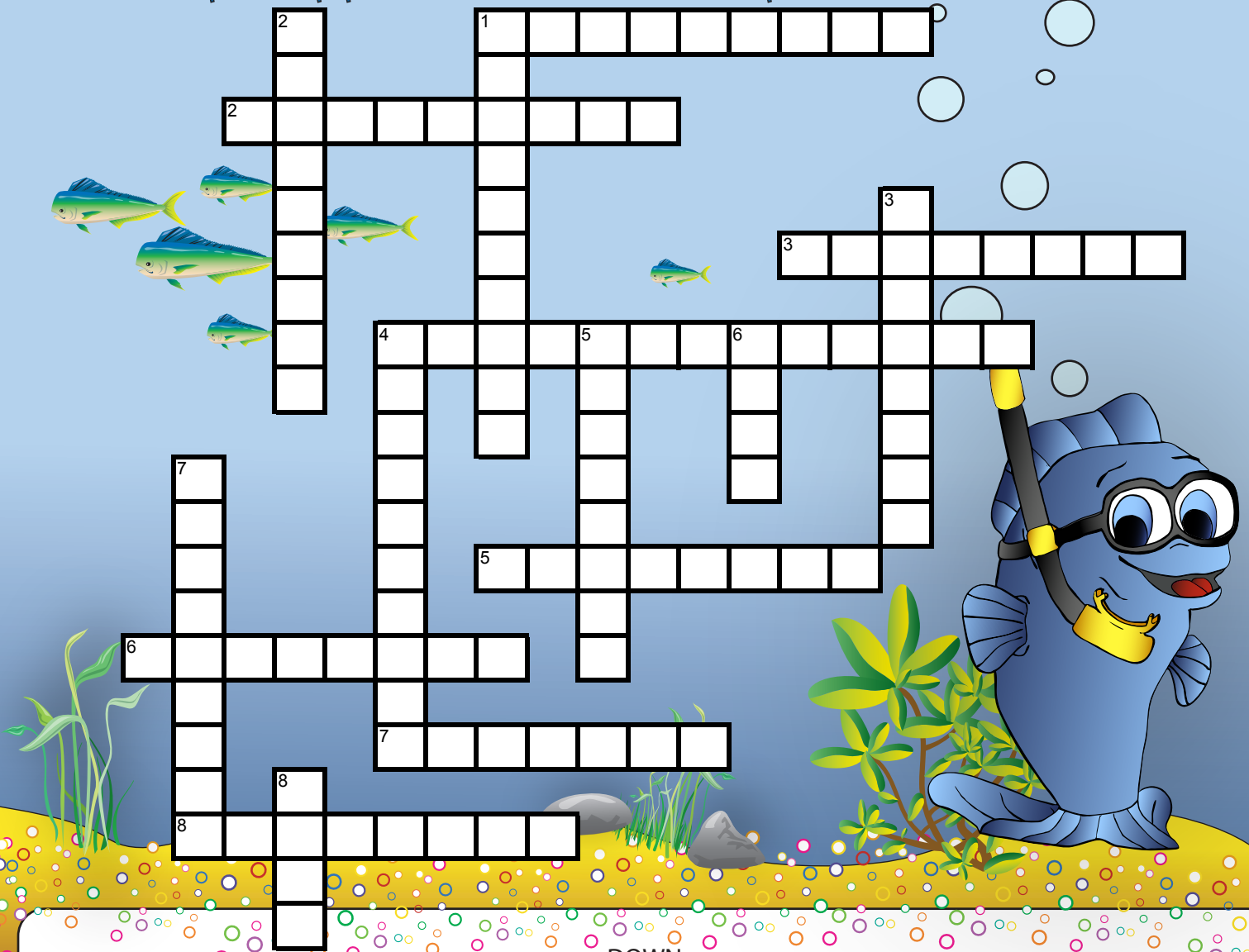


# Help Flippy find ways to keep our creeks clean
