

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids addressed to Eddie Zapata, Project Manager, City of Round Rock Department of Utilities & Environmental Services, 2008 Enterprise Drive, Round Rock, TX 78664, for furnishing all labor, material and equipment, and performing all work required for the project titled 2014 Wastewater Collection System Rehabilitation, Basins BC08, BC21-Z, BC22-Z, BC23-Z, EW01-Z, OC27-Z, OC28-Z, OC29-Z, OC30-Z, OC31-Z, and OC46-Z (project includes 4,404 LF of 8" through 18" pipe bursting and rehabilitation of 371 manholes, 3,273 LF of 8" through 10" pipe by open cut, 10 point repairs, 10,617 LF of 6" through 24" CIPP Liner, and construction of 8 manholes) will be received until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday July 30, 2015 then publicly opened and read aloud at the same address. Bid envelopes shall state date and time of bid and "2014 Wastewater Collection System Rehabilitation, Basins BC08, BC21-Z, BC22-Z, BC23-Z, EW01-Z, OC27-Z, OC28-Z, OC29-Z, OC30-Z, OC31-Z, and OC46-Z". Bids must also be accompanied by a "Statement of Bidder's Safety Experience" included in Section 410 of the Project Manual. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled opening time. Any bids received after scheduled bid opening time will be returned unopened.

Bids must be submitted on City of Round Rock bid forms and must be accompanied by an acceptable bid security as outlined in the Instructions to Bidders, payable to the City of Round Rock, Texas equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid amount. Contractors and subcontractors shall pay to laborers, workmen, and mechanics the prevailing wage rates as determined by the City of Round Rock.
