NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids addressed to **Eddie Zapata, Project Manager, City of Round Rock, Utilities and Environmental Services Department, 2008 Enterprise Drive, Round Rock, TX 78664**, for furnishing all labor, material and equipment and performing all work required for the project titled "**County Road 112 – 24' Waterline Extension**" (project includes a base bid construction of approximately 5,200 feet of 24" water line, 275 feet of 42 inch min. steel encasement pipe by bore, fire hydrants, valves and appurtenances). An alternate bid will include the construction of approximately 950 feet of 24" water line, fire hydrants, valves and appurtenances will be received until **2:00 p.m., Thursday, September 4, 2014** then publicly opened and read aloud at the same address. Bid envelopes shall state date and time of bid and "**County Road 112 – 24' Waterline Extension**". Bids must also be accompanied by a "Statement of Bidder's Safety Experience" included in Section 410 of the Project Manual. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled opening time. Any bids received after scheduled bid opening time will be returned unopened.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 2:00 p.m., Thursday August 28, 2014 at 2008 Enterprise Drive, Round Rock, Texas 78664.

Bids must be submitted on City of Round Rock bid forms and must be accompanied by an acceptable bid security as outlined in the Instructions to Bidders, payable to the City of Round Rock, Texas equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid amount. Plans, Bid Forms, Specifications, and Instructions to Bidders may be obtained from Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP located at 1008 South Main Street, Georgetown, Texas 78626, telephone number (512) 819-9478 for a non-refundable charge of \$50 per set. Plans will be available on Monday, August 18, 2014.

In case of ambiguity, duplication, or obscurity in the bids, the City of Round Rock reserves the right to construe the meaning thereof. The City of Round Rock further reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities and irregularities in the bids received.

The successful bidder will be expected to execute the City of Round Rock's standard contract and to furnish performance and payment bonds, all as described in the bid documents. Contractors and subcontractors shall pay to laborers, workmen, and mechanics the prevailing wage rates as determined by the City of Round Rock.
