

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids addressed to Danny Halden, P.E., City Engineer, City of Round Rock Utilities and Environmental Services Department, 2008 Enterprise Drive, Round Rock, TX 78664, for furnishing all labor, material and equipment and performing all work required for the project titled Deep Wood Drive Box Culvert Repair (project includes traffic control, removal and re-installation of traffic/pedestrian railing, removal and replacement of approximately 170 square feet of concrete sidewalk and 20 square feet of concrete culvert deck, and miscellaneous items) will be received until 2 p.m. November 11, 2014 then subsequently opened, read, and evaluated by the City of Round Rock (hereinafter "the City"). Bid envelopes shall state "**Sealed Bid-Deep Wood Drive Box Culvert Repair**". Bids must be accompanied by a "Statement of Bidder's Safety Experience" contained in Section 410 of the Project Manual. Any bids received after the aforementioned date/time deadline will be rejected.

Bids must be submitted on the Bid Form contained in Section 00300 of the Project Manual. Bid, contract, and plans documents and appropriate references for applicable instructions are contained in the Project Manual. The Project Manual is only available to bidders in electronic format and may be obtained under the listing for "Capital Improvement Active Solicitations" at the following web address:

A pre-bid conference will be conducted by the City on Thursday, November 6, 2014 from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. at 2008 Enterprise Drive, Round Rock, Texas.

All bids received may be evaluated based on the best value for the City. In determining best value, the City may consider: bid price; safety record of the bidder; reputation of the bidder and the bidder's quality of work; bidder's past experience in performing work similar to the Work contemplated by the City under this Notice; subcontractors proposed by the bidder; attendance at the pre-bid conference; and/or bidder's past relationship with the City.

In case of ambiguity, duplication, or obscurity in the bids, the City reserves the right to construe the meaning thereof. The City also reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities and irregularities in the bids received. The City further reserves the right to reject a part of a bid, to award to serve the best interests of the City, or to split award, as determined at the sole discretion of the City.

Contractors and subcontractors shall pay to laborers, workmen, and mechanics the prevailing wage rates as determined by the City.
