Recent Accomplishments

- ✓ Representative from the District, City, and consultant team explored the prospective dam sites. The team shared local knowledge and walked both sites to gain a better understanding of the topography, geologic features, potential challenges, etc.
- ✓ City and District representatives attended a neighborhood meeting with Greater Round Rock West Neighborhood Association to provide an update on the projects and answer resident's questions.

Current Activities

COORDINATION & FUNDING

- City and District representatives are responding to local media inquiries to ensure that any coverage is accurate and appropriately tempered in consideration of the project's fluidity and challenges.
- City will continue pursuit of funding partners and start grant funding search for the Dam 101 project.

DESIGN & PERMITTING

- District, City and design team personnel are researching and acquiring existing environmental, geologic, and geotechnical information to leverage the previous investigations done in the area including those for area utilities, O'Connor Drive, and SH45.
- Design team will spend most of February updating and finalizing the H&H models and incorporating information from the field visits to refine the required size and likely locations of Dams 101 and 102.

Next Major Milestones

COMBINED EFFORT

- Complete preliminary geologic and geotechnical assessment. (February 2015)
- Complete refinement of concepts for Dams 9, 101, and 102. (March 2015)
- Meet with property owner to discuss refined concepts. (April 2015)

• Project goal is to start preliminary design by spring 2015.
