

Historic Round Rock

105 East Main “Johnson Drug Store”

Built 1876

William Cade and Joseph Lockett owned this lot in 1876 when the building was erected. In 1883, they sold the building to Dr. J. H. Johnson, who operated a paint and drugstore, later adding stationery and other goods. Dr. Johnson ran the business until 1907, when S. A. Pennington opened a jewelry store inside. Pennington also ran a skating rink in town. By 1909, this was a pool hall; in 1916, a dry goods and grocery; and in 1937, a restaurant. In 1977, it was a furniture and appliance store.
