

# Historic Round Rock

202 East Main    “Wiess Store/Carlson’s Dry Goods”    Built 1907

In 1877, F. Holloman sold this lot to Massena Wiess. He operated a store at this location until 1890. Wiess’ partners included William Triggs. In 1885, this was a saloon and billiards. B. C. Halverson bought the property in 1890 and operated a blacksmith shop. S. W. Palm owned the lot from 1894 to 1907, and a cobbler was in business in 1902. In 1907, the current building was part of the Nelson family’s mercantile. By 1938, Jim Carlson operated a dry goods and shoe store in this half of the building.
