Recent Accomplishments

- ✓ The UBCWCID coordinated with property owners of the proposed sites for Dams 101 & 102 to gain access for consultants and staff to perform the necessary in-field activities to continue environmental investigations and design refinement.
- ✓ Dam 102 - The UBCWCID Board authorized an engineering services contract to investigate environmental and geologic conditions as well as potential dry utility conflicts.
- ✓ Dam 101 - The City Council authorized a contract to perform a geophysical assessment which is a minimally invasive method to investigate the ground underlying the proposed dam footprint.

Current Activities

COORDINATION & FUNDING

- The City is pursuing a grant expert to assist with understanding the regulatory and scheduling impacts of each potential funding source (NRCS, FEMA, etc.) as well as the potential benefits.

DESIGN & PERMITTING

- Dam 102 - The UBCWCID Board is expected to take action on multiple work authorizations in fiscal year 2016 that would authorize additional services to finalize preliminary and final design and permitting phases.
- Dam 101 - The City is expected to take action on multiple consultant contracts by the end of 2015 that would authorize additional environmental, geotechnical, modeling services to finalize the concept design.

Next Major Milestones

DAM 101

- Project goal is to start preliminary design by Summer 2016.

- Project goal is to start final design by Summer 2016.
