

PROVIDE CLOSE AND CONSTANT ATTENTION TO CHILDREN YOU ARE SUPERVISING IN AND NEAR THE WATER



ALL CHILDREN 12 YEARS AND UNDER REQUIRE ACTIVE SUPERVISION BY AN ADULT.

The role of a ACTIVELY SUPERVISING ADULT differs from that of a lifeguard. The Adult's role is to watch and PREVENT emergencies. A lifeguard is trained to rescue in the event of an emergency.

Teach children who cannot swim to stay away from water unless accompanied by a qualified adult. A qualified adult knows how to swim, stays within arm's reach of the child, and maintains eye to eye contact with the child.
