




Gattis School Road Project Fact Sheet

Gattis School Road is a major east west arterial stretching from IH-35 to SH-130 and traffic has significantly increased over the years. In February 2016, the Round Rock City Council approved and allocated funds to study Gattis School Rd. from Via Sonoma Trail to Red Bud Lane and hired BGE to perform the study and develop designs. The purpose of this study is to address the rapid growth and increased traffic along Gattis School Road.

Potential Improvements:

- Widening Gattis School Road from 4 to 6 lanes with a divided section from Via Sonoma to Red Bud Lane
- Installing a raised median
- Improvements on Red Bud Lane at Gattis School Road



Community Involvement

Working closely with property owners, residents, local business owners, and the community throughout the project is a priority for the City of Round Rock. Both the City and the project engineer will work with the community to collect and incorporate input and provide updates on the project as they become available.

Public Meetings

We are holding a public meeting Tuesday July 12, 2016 from 5 p.m. – 7 p.m. at Faith Baptist Church, 3625 Gattis School Rd., where we will share project information and preliminary design schematics. Attendees will have the opportunity to review maps and visit with project team members to ask questions and share their comments on the project. Another public meeting is planned for fall 2016 to present refined schematics.
