Online tips:

You may log up to 400 minutes per day—it's not important to keep a daily record, just the total number of minutes or books. Be sure to record your completed missions, too.

Remember, you may go online with the Library's computers or free WiFi. The teen volunteers at the Summer Reading table are also happy to help.


Level 4: 1200 Points (15 hours or 80 books)
