Posters will be judged on artistry, creativity, originality, and the ability to communicate the importance of water in our everyday lives.

The winning poster in each of the four age brackets will receive a gift card, public recognition and a picture with the Mayor during the November 8th City Council Meeting, as well as have their artwork displayed in City Hall through the end of December.
