TRAIL BOSS MESSAGE

Howdy Outlaw Trail Riders,

Welcome to the 32nd Annual Outlaw Trail Cycling Tour established in 1987. We hope you enjoy the Saturday trail ride and our Post-Ride Tailgate Party. Hopefully, our Outlaw Trail shirt, drinking glass and other pocket loot will serve as a fond reminder of Round Rock hospitality.

For a Safe & Enjoyable Ride, Please Read the Following Important Info:

START:

The tour will begin at 8:00 AM sharp. Cyclists will line up according to the start order. 63 mile cyclists will lead off, followed by 50 mile, 40 mile, 25 mile and 10 mile cyclists. Look for your staging area. There will be a three to five minute lag between each group's start. Helmets are mandatory and headphones are not recommended due to the importance to be able to hear instructions, oncoming vehicles and other cyclists on the course.

TOUR NUMBERS: The small number is to be affixed to your helmet and the large double number wraps around the top tube of your bike with peel and stick to attach.

COURSES AND AID STATIONS:

Color-coded pistols will mark the course for each distance, but be sure to take your map on the tour as well. A full course map is included your packet and individual route maps and GPS downloads are available at www.OutlawTrail100.com. Riders needing assistance due to emergencies or getting off-course should call the command post telephone at 512-937-9743. This phone will only be answered on event day from 8:00am-2:00pm.

CYCLISTS MUST OBEY ALL TRAFFIC LAWS. The future of this event is dependent on it. Please use proper cycling etiquette. Rules of the Road are included in your packet. The aid stations (AS) are designated on the route map by the blue circles and are located every 6.8 – 16 miles. Please assist us by making sure you and your bike are completely off the main road while you are getting refreshed. If you are finishing the trail non-stop, you will need to carry adequate provisions as no follow vehicles are allowed.

- Watch for loose gravel at all intersections.
- Use caution when traveling on the busier roads such as FM 1105 and FM 1660, & when crossing SH 29 and FM 971.

FINISH:

The course will close at 2:00 pm. Ride officials will not record finish times. A clock will display times at the finish line.

TAILGATE PARTY:

Starting at 10:00am, registered cyclists can grab some grub and wet their whistle with various beverages, including beer for those 21+, at our Post-Ride Tailgate Party. Our grub will include BBQ sandwiches, pizza and various snacks. Live football viewing will be set up for you to enjoy as you cheer on fellow riders who are returning. The party will end at 2:30 pm.

Rentsch Brewery from Georgetown, Texas will be featured offering varieties of craft beer for those 21+ throughout the Tailgate Party. Booths will also be set up with giveaways to add to your loot.
