This major invitational show will include approximately 70 sculptors in an outdoor event on Centennial Plaza in the City of Round Rock, located in the greater Austin area. **No Application or Entry Fees** for this celebration, and **No Commissions on Sales**. **FREE Admission for visitors!**

Purchase Sculpture and Space for Large Pieces:

- A sculpture for a public art collection will be purchased from an artist who exhibits at SculptFest.
- Space is available for exhibiting large sculptures during SculptFest.

Event Management, Marketing and Advertising:

Scot Wilkinson, the City's Director of Arts and Culture, is the SculptFest event director. Significant funds in the Arts and Culture budget are allocated for marketing and advertising SculptFest.

April 24 - Friday: Set-Up 8:00am - 3:00pm (Individual Set-Up time to be scheduled)

April 24 - Friday: SculptFest 4:00 pm - 8:00pm

April 25 - Saturday: 10:00am - 8:00pm April 27 - Sunday: 10:00am - 4:00pm

Entry - Deadline Jan. 30, 2020 and Acceptance by Feb. 15th:

Application Preparation:

On a computer, download the Application Form at: www.tsos.org/sculptfest/ Open the .pdf Application Form.

Complete the Fillable Form on a computer {you can type on this Fillable Form}. Save the .pdf with file name: "your last name-first name_SculptFest2019".

Images:

Send one image each of a maximum of four sculptures representing your work. Images: .jpg format only, 1080 pixels on the longest side; Resolution 72 pixels/inch Image File Name Format: your last name-first name_title of sculpture "Smith-Jane_Horse"

Submit Application and Images:

Submit by email to: SculptFest@roundrocktexas.gov Subject: "SculptFest Application-your last name"

Attach completed Application Form and 4 .jpg images to your email submission.

Submitting images grants permission to use images for public relations and advertising purposes for 28th SculptFest.

Policies and Procedures:

Open to sculptors exhibiting in a permanent medium.

No application or entry fees.

No commissions charged on sales.

Sculptors handle all sales and sales taxes with their customers.

Deadline for Entry Jan. 30, 2020. Acceptance by Feb. 15, 2020.

Sculptors provide pedestals for artwork.

Tents provided by the City of Round Rock.

 10×10 ft. space is allocated within a number of large white tents with lights.

You may Request 10 x 20 or more space if needed, to be approved by the jury.

Request space for large sculptures in your email submission.

A fork lift team provided for assistance with set-up and reloading.

At set-up, sculptures determined to be unsafe will be rejected.

Set-up time will be scheduled in advance.

Electric power will be available.

No late arrivals for set-up or early departures permitted.
