- All vendors and non-food vendors serving unwrapped food: You must have a Williamson County Health Permit. http://www.wcchd.org/ for an online permit or call 512-248-7620. You will not be able to enter the area without proof of a permit reflecting the festival dates and all requiment required by WCCHD.
- All food and drink vendors should be self contained.
- Electrical and Water is provided.
- A 10' x 10' area provided on pavement. If more room is needed, please let SculptFest officials know your needs.
- Setup is Friday, April 24th from 8:00 am 4:30 pm. Festival grounds close 30 minutes prior of opening each day.
- You will be able to drive to your designated area at Centennial Plaza. Then the area is blocked off. Have a dolly. Please consider bringing others to help you during load in, during the festival and load out.
- Wifi is available but a hot spot is a better option.
