TRIP GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

The Baca Center plans trips for adults 50+ within a 2.5 hour radius and travels to various cities, museums, theaters, restaurants, holiday lights, performances, and many more places of interest. **Please read and review our policies and procedures for participating on trips**. By registering, you acknowledge and accept the guidelines and procedures.

- Cost for trips listed is the cost for members, non-members pay \$5 additional for each trip. All payments are due at the time of registration.
- Members can register one additional person (50+) at the time of registration, however if they are a non-member, we will need their address, phone number, date of birth and a signed waiver.
- Due to the bus configuration, there is room for only one wheelchair on trips. Participants with a disability or a physical condition requiring them to use a wheelchair MUST call Dawn to register on the day of registration. Some trips may indicate no wheelchair due to the venue or no safe location to load/unload the lift. Wheelchair participants MUST be accompanied by a companion or caregiver to assist with accessibility situations. The bus driver can only give assistance loading/unloading off the bus.
- Please arrive NO MORE than 30 minutes prior to a trip and NO LESS than 15 minutes. All participants MUST be on the bus no less than 5 minutes prior to departure. If you are late, the bus will leave you behind and there will be no refund for the trip.
- Participants can save ONE additional seat. The seat you select is your seat for the entire trip. You must follow all instructions given by the bus driver such as asking to relocate or share seats. Those that fail to do so may not be permitted on future trips for up to six months.
- Participants are not permitted to meet us at the trip location and all participants that ride to a location must return on the bus.
- Participants taking trips during Baca business hours, are asked to park in the <u>lower level</u> of the garage or Centennial Plaza parking lot. If able, please leave the handicap spaces for members attending the center.
- Only those registered for a trip can participate. There are NO last minute registrations and NO substitutions on the day of the trip.
- Times and events are subject to change. Return time is an estimated time of return, depending on traffic, event wrap up, and any travel delays. When appropriate the bus may be available to board and wait until the entire group has returned to the bus at the designated time, **this does not mean the trip will be returning early**.
- Those that return to the bus more than 10 minutes late to the designated meeting time may not be permitted on future trips for up to six months.
- Cost for meals will vary by type of restaurant. Participants are responsible for checking meal costs ahead of time through restaurant/venue website. An 8-20% gratuity may be charged.
- Snacks/drinks are permitted on the bus. For long trips, we may only stop for lunch, so bring food for later. The bus stops every 1.5 hours for a restroom break provided the trip is longer than 2 hours away.
- Please be sure to double check for your items when leaving the bus and please dispose of your trash.
- Call the Baca Center for lost and found items left on the bus.

TRIP CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event of a cancellation, a CREDIT for the amount of the trip will be added to your account **ONLY** IF:

- 1) The Allen R. Baca Center cancels the trip.
- 2) A substitution has been made from the waiting list to fill your spot.

A) If no substitution can be made and the request is made 14 calendar days or less from the start date of the trip, all fees are forfeited.

B) If no substitution can be made and the request is made 14 calendar days or more from the start date of the trip, a credit for the amount of the trip will be applied to your account or you will be assessed a \$25 processing fee for a refund.

VARIOUS TRIP INFORMATION/UPDATES—PLEASE READ

There are a few places in Texas that we would LOVE to visit however for various reasons that is not possible. The center only travels within a 2.5 hour radius. Here is a compiled list of some locations that have been requested and why we are not able to visit.

- 1. *Magnolia Restaurant* in Waco—They do not take reservations and the line is usually wrapped around the building.
- 2. *Bamberger Ranch*—The ranch charges a fee of \$25/person for a tour. For our value, that is too high of a fee for a trip.
- 3. *Johnson City Exotic Zoo*—This ranch no longer does tours, you must stay overnight to tour the ranch.
- 4. Casinos—We do not do overnight trips and there are no casinos close enough to the center for a day trip.
- 5. *Governor's Mansion*—They require a current driver's license for each person on the trip 2 weeks in vance to run a background check. This is not feasible for a trip.
- 6. *Houston, Galveston, Dallas, Ft. Worth, etc.*—There are great things to see in these towns, however they are just outside of our 2.5 hour maximum.
- 7. Various Restaurants—There are some restaurants that will not accept reservations or they are unable to fit a full trip of 30 participants inside their restaurants. These restaurants are unfeasible for our group. Please feel free to give us your trip suggestions that are within our travel parameters.


If you have NEVER accessed your account online, we will need to send you a temporary password. Please request it at from the Baca Center Front Desk or call 512-218-5549 PRIOR to January 27.

If you have accessed your account online before, but don't know your password, select Forgot Your Password and a temporary one will be emailed to you. The email address must match the one we have on file for you. If you are unsure of the email we have on file for you, please request it at from the Baca Center Front Desk or call 512-218-5549 PRIOR to January 27.

2. **IN PERSON AT THE BACA CENTER**—This will be first come, first served with numbers handed out at 7:00 am when the building opens. Registration will begin at 8:00 am sharp. Please have your trip registration sheet completed and your payment ready to expedite the process. There is no need to arrive at the center before 7:00 am.

3. **PHONE IN REGISTRATION**—Please only call ONCE and leave a short message with your name and phone number. Calls will be returned in the order they are received. Calling more than once will not get you registered any quicker, as we will not be answering the phone until all phone calls have been returned. Please have your trip sheet completed and your payment ready. Make sure you keep your phone and this information handy. If we call and you do not answer, you will go to the bottom of the list.

Full payment is due at the time of registration. We accept cash, check made to City of Round Rock, Visa or Mastercard. Only credit cards will be an acceptable form of payment over the phone. If you would like to register one other person and they are NOT on your account, we will need name, address, date of birth and phone number and signed waiver to complete their registration. Please remember, only those 50+ can travel with the Baca Center and non-members pay an additional \$5/trip.
