Items can be placed on the curb as early as 2/29 Place items for pickup **NO LATER** than 8 a.m. 3/7

What is allowed:



- Non-Freon appliances (washer, dryer, stove etc.) (Provide 2 feet of side clearance for appliances)
- Carpeting, furniture, mattresses
- Scrap metal (must be less than 4' long)
- Treated wood (fence materials)
- Tree limbs
 - Limbs must not exceed 8" in diameter
 - Limbs must not exceed 15' in length
 - No palm tree or cacti limbs will be accepted
 - Bamboo must be bundled

What is not allowed:



- Freon appliances (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners)
- Televisions and computers (contact appliance recyclers)
- Automotive products/fluids (take to Recycling Center)
- Paint (accepted at Recycling Center)
- Hazardous chemicals (accepted at Recycling Center)
- Demolition/construction debris or metal fencing
- Tires, Batteries, Ammunition, Explosives
- Concrete or rocks, Railroad tie lumber
- Pianos, hot tubs, motorcycles (items larger than a normal size appliance

Brush Guidelines



- Make a separate pile for brush that has required separation
- Keep brush pile 5 feet from everything
- Keep a 15 foot clearance over brush



- Mix in treated wood (fencing) or trash
- You do not have to bundle
- Park in front of piles





GET A CHECKUP TO MAKE SURE THAT...

- Smoke detectors are working (<u>FREE</u> detectors if you need them)
- Smoke detector batteries are good (FREE batteries replaced by volunteers)
- Appliances have not been recalled

Smoke detectors and batteries are provided for free. If you have an electric stove you may be eligible for a fire suppression device.
