



Water Conservation Pilot Program

Better Bathroom Rebate Guidelines

This rebate applies to residential properties for the purchase of WaterSense Certified toilets, showerheads, and faucet aerators. Replacing older toilets with water efficient toilets can save 4,000 gallons of water per toilet, per year. Updating showerheads can save up to 2,700 gallons of water per year, which will also reduce energy costs. And replacing old faucets and aerators can save up to 700 gallons per year.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a direct City of Round Rock water customer in good standing. (MUD customers are not eligible.)
- Property must have been built prior to January 1, 2006.
- Toilet rebates will be denied if the property has participated in past City of Round Rock toilet rebate programs.
- Property must be a single-family home or duplex.
- An itemized receipt(s) must be submitted with the application within 60-days of installation. Receipt(s) must include date, vendor name, fixture(s) price, and brand or description.
- The City does not endorse specific brands, nor is responsible for the performance or repair of new fixture(s).
- Applicant is responsible for disposal of old fixture(s). Per state law they cannot be reused.
- Rebates are available until funds have been expended. Visit roundrocktexas.gov/rebates for available rebates.

FIXTURE REQUIREMENTS:

- New toilets, showerheads, and faucets or faucet aerators **must** be EPA WaterSense Certified to qualify for the rebate. Find products at <https://lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products/> (New product packaging is marked with the WaterSense label shown on this application.)



REBATE DETAILS:

- Rebate amount is 50% of the cost of the new fixture, not taxes or any delivery/shipping fees.
- Maximum rebate is \$500 per water account, per year.
- Number of toilets, showerheads, and faucets rebated will not exceed the number of bathrooms at the property currently. This is for the replacement of old fixtures; new home additions are not eligible.
- You may be contacted for a final inspection.
- Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after application has been processed and approved.
- This is a pilot program and may be ended at any time, without notice.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Read the Program Guidelines to ensure eligibility.
2. When project is complete, submit application and itemized receipt(s) within 60-days of installation.
3. All new fixtures must be [WaterSense labeled](#).
4. No pre-inspection is necessary; however, you may be contacted for a final inspection.
5. Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after application has been processed and approved.
