

City of Round Rock Swim Lessons COVID-19 Guidelines

General

- Stay home if you or your child are feeling sick.
- Stay a minimum of 6 feet from other families and patrons in deck areas.
- Changing areas and showers will be limited. Please arrive in your swimsuit ready to get in the water. It is recommended to change and shower at home following your pool visit.
- Use hand sanitizer after leaving the pool. When you get home, wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Swim Lessons

- Swimmers will not be allowed to enter the pool until the instructor indicates class is starting.
- Class size will be limited to max of 6 students.
- Equipment used by class participants will be cleaned between classes. Students will be encouraged to bring their own diving rings, kick boards, noodle, and/or goggles.
- Encourage all students to maintain a safe distance apart during class, especially out of the water.
- Instructors will assist students from the side rather than the front when close proximity is needed.
- All Pre-School classes will have the option for a parent/guardian to participate in the water with their child to allow social distance to be maintained. It is optional for the Pre-School guardian to be in the water with the child to participate in skills.
- Older levels of the Swim Program (Level 1-5) will encourage students to maintain a safe distance between participants. Levels 1-2 will stay in the shallow end of the pool where children may touch the ground.
- Any swimmer with a fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms, will not be allowed to swim.
- Swimmers will be allowed to make up missed classes due to illness in later sessions, by arrangement.
- All swimmers will be expected to get out of the pool in a timely manner so that equipment can be cleaned for the next session.
- Safety precautions will be updated daily.
