PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR



No Running



No Diving in Shallow Water



No Fighting or Rough Play



No Riding on Shoulders

Children must be 12 years or older to enter the facility without an adult.

PROPER SWIM ATTIRE:

A swimsuit must be worn at all times in the swimming pool. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SWIM ATTIRE GUIDELINES

Proper swim attire must be worn whenever enjoying a City of Round Rock public pool. Proper swim attire is defined as articles of clothing made of materials designed for use in the water. If you have any questions regarding what is or is not considered proper swim attire, please refer to the quick reference guide below or seek the assistance of an aquatics team member.

Swim wear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal ornamentation are not allowed in the water. Underwear is not allowed. Thong bikinis, revealing swimwear and see through attire is prohibited. Lifeguard apparel is also not allowed in any City of Round Rock public pool facility.

Cover-ups for modesty or sun protection may be worn in addition to proper swim attire. Aquatics Team Members reserve the right to have final interpretation of all pool rules.
