### Project Timeline


2021: Preliminary design complete

### Project Funding

The City of Round Rock is funding design for the project. A combination of city and county funds may be used for construction.





## Project Overview

#### Why is this project needed?

- Old Settlers Boulevard serves as an important east-west roadway to connect residents to other major roadways and community destinations
- Supports the City's goal to improve mobility throughout the community and meet the demands of growth
- Reduces travel time to destinations in east Round Rock





## Project Goals

As Round Rock continues to grow, the City is committed to providing safe travel, reducing time spent in traffic, and improving mobility for all types of transportation. The City has established the following goals for this project:

- Provide adequate capacity for increasing traffic volumes
- Improve mobility for local traffic
- Provide safe turns to and from neighborhoods
- Improve mobility for pedestrians and bicycles
- Provide crossing at McNutt Creek
- Minimize additional right of way needs
- Evaluate potential impacts to the community and environment
- Engage the community in the process




## Proposed Improvements

- Construct a new four-lane extension with a center median and dedicated left-turn lanes
- Construct twin bridges over McNutt Creek
- Construct a closed storm drain with curbs and gutters
- Construct a continuous shared-use path and continuous sidewalk
- Construct fencing along Old Settlers Boulevard at neighborhood park



#### Porano Circle at Old Settlers Boulevard


Two-way stop

## **Community and Environmental Considerations**

The design process includes evaluating potential impacts to the community and natural environment. The design team and the City are developing this project with many considerations in mind.

- Coordination with Siena MUD and utility providers to utilize available space and reduce footprint of improvements
- Incorporating construction best practices for McNutt Creek crossings
- Coordinating with property owners where right of way may be needed
- Providing opportunity for community feedback
