Game Play Procedures/Rules:

Game baskets will be provided with basic supplies to play (i.e. 1 shuffler per table/set of cards, dominoes) and placed in the room. All participants will need to scan in at the front desk and then sign-in on activity sheet in the room prior to play. Players will need to place used items back in the basket and leave in the room for our team to sanitize. Items will be sanitized and/or quarantined for 72 hours before loaned out again. Rooms will be set with 5 tables, 4 chairs per table for a total of 20 participants per play time. Participants are welcome to bring their own snacks and drinks however sharing of food is not encouraged. Cabinets will NOT be available to players and those needing special/specific personal equipment will need to bring your own and cannot leave at the center.

NEW PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Baca Backyard Series—Baggers Cornhole: Cornhole has been around for centuries as a lawn game similar to horseshoes. It's not just about tossing a bean bag into a hole but using strategy to knockout your opponent's bag for points. This weekly program takes place on **Thursdays, 4:30-6:30 pm** in the Dining Room. There will be 2 cornhole stations and play will begin with the first 4 participants that have signed the attendance sheet. Play will be the best 2 out of 3 games with a score of 21. Players will rotate out of play for new players. Baggers are welcome to bring their own beverage of choice. Rules will be posted in the room for participants to follow. Come see how exciting and challenging cornhole can be.

Ballet Folklorico: This NEW group meets weekly on **Tuesdays** in the Dining Room from **6:00-7:00 pm**. Join Yolanda Sanchez, Director of Round Rock Ballet Folklorico for an hour of Mexican Folk Dancing. Participants will learn: Mexican Folk Dancing, choreography, history, get exercise and above all, have FUN!! This program is open to adults 50+, no special shoes or costumes needed to participate. Cost will be \$4/class for Baca members and \$5 for non-members. *Registration in advance is required.*
