GLAMPING IN TIPIS ON THE GUADALUPE RIVER

Gather up your friends for our first overnight glamping trip! Glamping is a much more luxurious way to camp than tent camping. We will depart Thursday at 9 am and head to New Braunfels for dining and shopping. It is suggested to eat in New Braunfels for dinner or feel free to cook in your tipi. We have reserved the entire venue and will check in to our tipis at 4 pm. Each tipi has 2 queen beds, TV, small kitchenette with a sink, refrigerator, hot plate, coffee maker, toaster oven and basic kitchen items that make it easy to cook simple meals (no microwave). All tipis have a designated private bathroom with a sink, commode, large walk-in tiled shower and linens. The bathrooms are located in separate buildings, close to each tipi. There is also cable, WiFi, a BBQ pit and fire pit for each tipi. Feel free to bring a small cooler, outdoor chair, charcoal/wood. Other amenities include ping pong, cornhole, volleyball, tetherball and direct access to the Guadalupe River. Kayak and inner tube rentals are available on site. We will go to breakfast for those that do not want to cook at 8 am on Friday at Wildflour Artisan Bakery & Grill. The restaurant has a large breakfast menu with many choices. Check out is firmly at 11 am and we will head back to Round Rock.

Two people are **required** per tipi and 3 tipis can accommodate up to 3 people.

When registering you will be asked for the names of everyone in your group. NO refunds can be permitted unless you find a substitute person for your reservation.
