APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTION**


The above captioned matters came before the Court on August 30, 2021, for a hearing on the Plaintiff's application for a temporary injunction.

Defendant, Glenn Hegar, in his Official Capacity as Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas, and Plaintiff, City of Round Rock, Texas have agreed to the terms of a temporary injunction in the above captioned case.

By agreement of the parties, the Court hereby enjoins the Comptroller from implementing or enforcing 34 Tex. Admin. Code § 3.334(b)(5) until a final hearing on the merits or further order from this Court.

Pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 6.002, no security or bond is required of the City of Round Rock.

The trial on the merits in *City of Round Rock, Texas v. Hegar* (Cause No. D-1-GN-21-3203) is set for the week of June 13, 2022.
