



# Water Conservation Program

## Better Bathroom Rebate Guidelines

This rebate applies to residential properties for the purchase of WaterSense Certified toilets, showerheads, bathroom faucets, and faucet aerators. Replacing older toilets with water-efficient toilets can save 4,000 gallons of water per toilet per year. Updating showerheads can save up to 2,700 gallons of water per year, and water-efficient faucets and aerators can save up to 700 gallons per year.

### PROGRAM GUIDELINES

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a direct City of Round Rock water customer in good standing. (MUD customers are not eligible)
- Property must be residential; a single-family home or duplex.
- Property must have been built prior to January 1, 2006.
- Toilet rebates will be denied if the property has participated in past City of Round Rock toilet rebate programs; property can still apply for showerheads and bathroom faucets.
- An itemized receipt(s) must be submitted with the application within 60-days of installation. Receipt(s) must include the purchase date, vendor name, fixture(s) price, and brand or description.
- Applicant is responsible for disposal of old fixture(s). Per state law, they cannot be reused.

#### FIXTURE REQUIREMENTS:

- New toilets, showerheads, and bathroom faucets or faucet aerators **must** be EPA WaterSense Certified to qualify for the rebate. Find products at [lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products](http://lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products) (*New product packaging is marked with the WaterSense label shown on this application.*)
- The City does not endorse specific brands, nor is responsible for the performance or repair of new fixture(s).



#### REBATE DETAILS:

- Rebate amount is 50% of the cost of the new fixture.
- Rebate amount calculation does not include tax or delivery/shipping costs.
- Maximum rebate is \$500 per water account per year.
- Number of toilets, showerheads, and faucets rebated may not exceed the number of existing bathrooms at the property. This is for the replacement of old fixtures; new home additions are not eligible.
- This program and may end at any time, without notice.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

1. Read the Program Guidelines to ensure eligibility.
2. When project is complete, submit application and itemized receipt(s) within 60-days of installation.
3. No pre-inspection is necessary; however, you may be contacted for a final inspection.
4. Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after application has been processed and approved.
