## **Hydrant Flow Test Procedures**

#### **Application Submission**

- The application is required to be submitted 7 days prior to the test being scheduled.
- The application should include a map that shows the locations of the Flow and the Static/Residual hydrants. This map should be acquired from the City of Round Rock GIS website with the waterline layers turned ON. <a href="https://maps.roundrocktexas.gov/cityview/">https://maps.roundrocktexas.gov/cityview/</a>
- The application information will be shared with the City of Round Rock Water Department to verify that the test can be properly conducted at the location requested. The Water Department will be notified of the date and time of testing by the Fire Marshal's Office.

### **Scheduling**

- Testing times will be available on **Thursdays at 8am, 10am, 1pm, and 3pm**. These times will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis to the requesting applicants.
- A test will not be scheduled until the \$100 inspection fee is received.
- An applicant that provides less than 24 hours' notice to cancel or reschedule a test will be required to pay an additional \$100 fee to perform the test.

## **Performing the Hydrant Flow Test**

- The requesting applicant will be responsible for performing the hydrant flow test. If the
  requesting applicant is not capable of performing a test, the applicant will be responsible for
  hiring a contractor to conduct the test on their behalf. An inspector from the Round Rock
  Fire Marshals office will witness the test.
- The applicant is required to provide calibrated gauges and equipment to perform the test. Calibration will be verified by the inspector witnessing the test.
- The inspector will verify that accurate test results are recorded. The individual who performed the test will provide a signature, confirming the test results.
