DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Round Rock, on the 21st day of March 2022, suffered injury to individuals and widespread and severe damage to property resulting from a severe thunderstorm that produced one or more tornadoes, and

WHEREAS the Mayor of Round Rock, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is thereby declared for Round Rock, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Round Rock, Texas.
- 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Clerk.
- 4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.
- 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
