Visit the water tower at dusk to see its new brilliant lighting

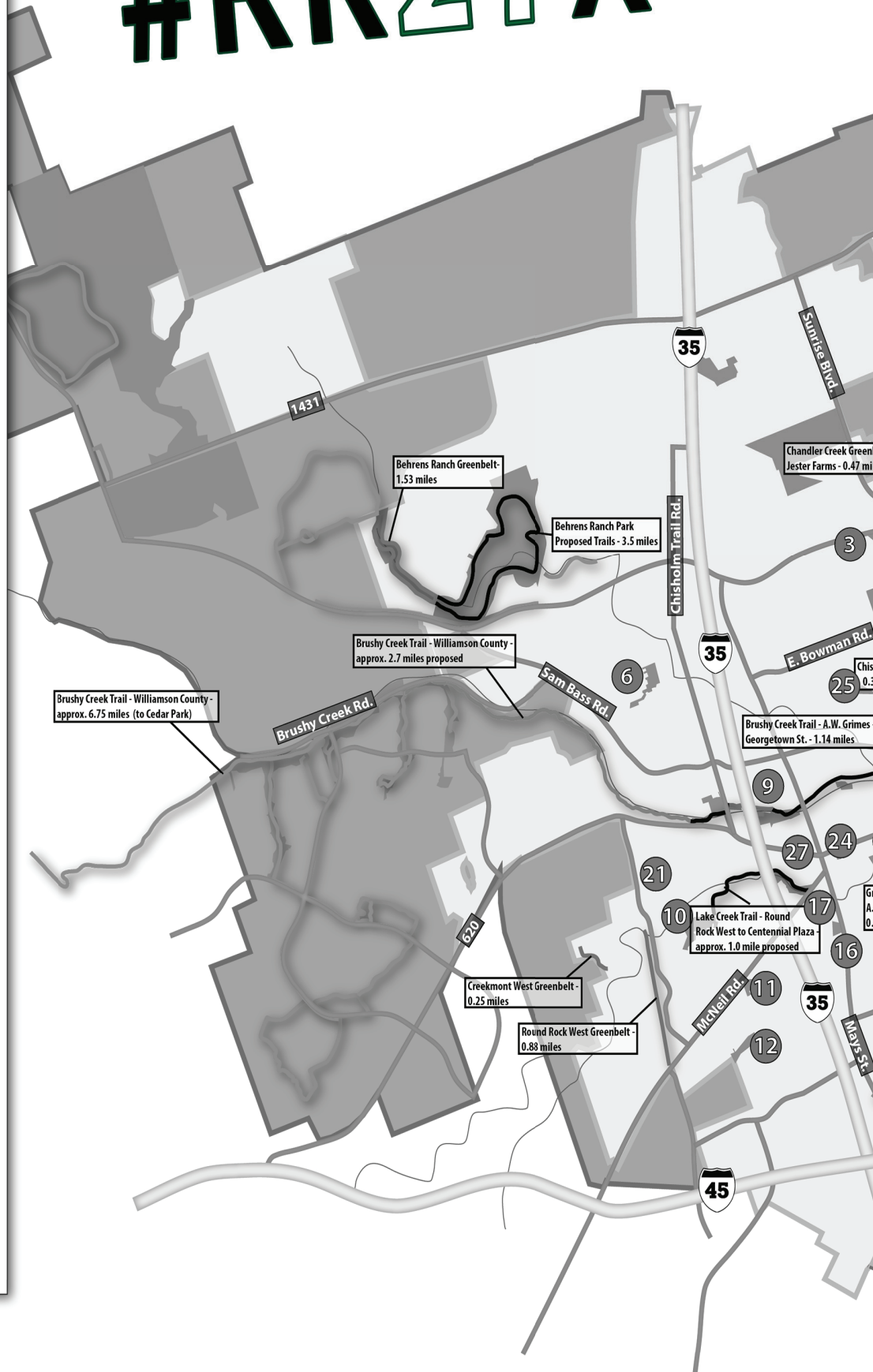

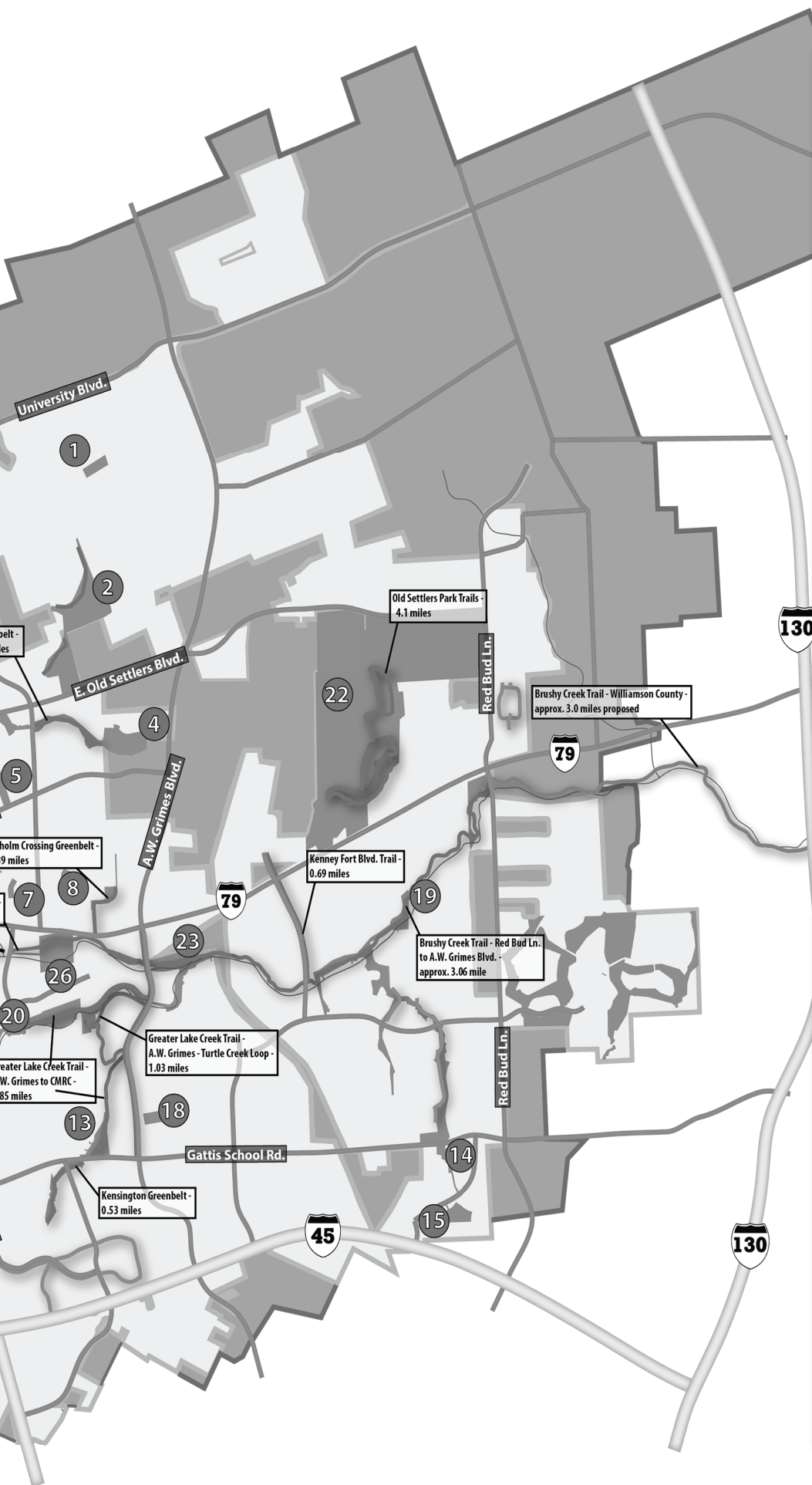
