



Water Conservation Commercial Bathroom Rebate

This rebate is for the purchase of WaterSense Labeled toilets, flush urinals, showerheads, and faucet aerators. Replacing older toilets with water efficient toilets can save 4,000 gallons of water per toilet, per year! Updating showerheads can save up to 2,700 gallons of water per year, and water-efficient faucets and aerators can save up to 700 gallons per year.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a direct City of Round Rock water customer in good standing. *(MUD customers are not eligible.)*
- Property must have been built prior to January 1, 2006.
- Property must be commercial, industrial, governmental, or apartments. *Irrigation-only accounts do not qualify.*
- An itemized receipt(s) must be submitted with the application within 90-days of installation. Receipt(s) must include date, vendor name and address, fixture(s) price, and brand or description.
- Applicant is responsible for disposal of old fixture(s). Per state law they cannot be reused or sold.

FIXTURE REQUIREMENTS:

- New toilets, flush urinals, showerheads, and faucets **must** be WaterSense Certified. Find products at lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products *(Product packaging is marked with the WaterSense label, shown here.)*
- Number of toilets, urinals, showerheads, or faucets rebated will not exceed the number of toilets and/or urinals at the property. The rebate is for the replacement of old fixtures only, not new expansions or additions.
- The City does not endorse specific brands, nor is responsible for the performance or repair of new fixture(s).



REBATE DETAILS:

- Rebate amount is 50% of the cost of the new fixture and installation costs.
- Rebate amount does not include sales tax or shipping costs.
- Maximum rebate is \$1000 per water account, per year.
- No pre-inspection is necessary; however, you may be contacted for a final inspection or asked to provide photos of the new fixtures.
- Submit one application per water account, along with itemized receipts within 90-days of installation.
- Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after application has been processed and approved.
- Rebates are available until funds have been expended. Visit roundrocktexas.gov/rebates to check status, if funds are exhausted the rebate program will be removed from the website.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Read the Program Guidelines to ensure eligibility.
2. When project is complete, submit application and itemized receipt(s) within 90-days of installation.
3. Submit a separate application for each water account.
4. No pre-inspection is necessary; however, you may be contacted for a final inspection.
5. Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after application has been processed and approved.
