The City of Round Rock, Texas (the City) is an annual recipient of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. As such, HUD requires local jurisdictions to undergo a consolidated planning process to assess their affordable housing and community development needs and market conditions, and to make data-driven, place-based investment decisions for their federal entitlement funding.

To facilitate this process, the City has retained Grow America (formerly the National Development Council) to help guide the City's Consolidated Planning Process. Grow America was established in 1969 and is the nation's oldest nonprofit community development organization, a Community Development Financial Institution, and a technical assistance provider in the areas of affordable housing, economic development, and community development planning to over 100 nonprofit and public sector entities. Patricia Santa Cruz and Laura Salinas-Martinez with Grow America will be leading this effort on behalf of the City of Round Rock and will initiate a comprehensive community engagement strategy that includes stakeholder consultations, focus group sessions, public hearings and a community needs survey in early-March 2024.
