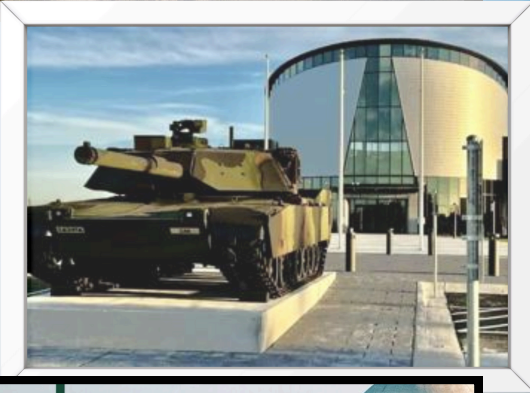
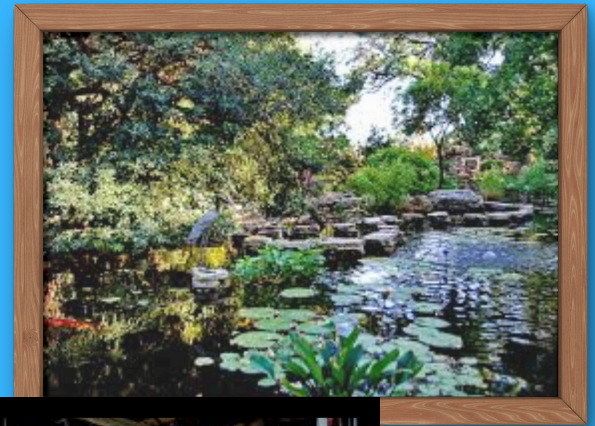

TRIP REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Here are the ways you can register for our trips:

1. **ONLINE at www.roundrockrecreation.com**—As a Baca Center member, you already have an online account with Round Rock Parks and Recreation Department. Please do NOT create a new account, as it will not recognize your membership and you will be charged the additional \$5 per trip. If you are unsure of what email we have on file for you or if you have difficulty logging in, please call us at 512-218-5499 or stop by the Lobby Desk.
2. **IN PERSON AT THE BACA CENTER**— Trip registration is available during membership hours.
3. **OVER THE PHONE** —Trip registration is available by calling 512-218-5499 during membership hours.

Full payment is due at the time of registration. We accept cash, check made to City of Round Rock, or credit cards. Payment over the phone can only be made with a credit card. If you would like to register one other person and they are NOT on your account, we will need **name, address, date of birth, phone number and signed waiver** to complete their registration. Please remember, only those 50+ can travel with the Baca Center.

Don't wait to register!

Trip will be cancelled if minimum is not met 3 days before trip date.

In the event of a cancellation by the Baca Center, you will receive a refund to your original payment method or a credit to your Parks and Recreation account.

ACTIVITY LEGEND FOR TRIPS

All trips will require independent walking from the bus to the entrance of locations and back to the bus. Some trips will require more walking due to the type of venue. These are just estimates of the amount of walking. Participants are encouraged to visit the venue website for more details.

The 45,000-square foot Texas Military Forces Museum explores the history of the Lone Star State's militia and volunteer forces from 1823 (date of the first militia muster in Stephen F. Austin's colony) to 1903 when the Congress created the National Guard. From 1903 to the present the museum tells the story of the Texas Army and Air National Guard, as well as the Texas State Guard, in both peacetime and wartime. Afterwards we'll stop at Billy's On Burnet, a casual, neighborhood-style American restaurant and bar known for its burgers and sandwiches. They offer a wide range of menu items, including burgers, sandwiches, appetizers, and sides.

TRIP GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

The Baca Center plans trips for adults 50+ within a 2.5 hour radius and travels to various cities, museums, theaters, restaurants, holiday lights, performances, and many more places of interest. **Please read and review our policies and procedures for participating on trips.** By registering, you acknowledge and accept the guidelines and procedures.











- ◆ Cost for trips listed is the cost for members, non-members pay \$5 additional for each trip. All payments are due at the time of registration.
- ◆ Members can register one additional person (50+) at the time of registration; however, if they are a non-member, we will need their address, phone number, date of birth and a signed waiver BEFORE registration.
- ◆ Due to the bus configuration, there is room for only one wheelchair on trips. Participants with a disability or a physical condition requiring them to use a wheelchair MUST call the Program Coordinator or Facility Supervisor to register. Some trips may indicate no wheelchair due to the venue or no safe location to load/unload the lift. Wheelchair participants MUST be accompanied by a companion or caregiver to assist with accessibility situations. The bus driver can only give assistance loading/unloading off the bus.
- ◆ Please arrive NO MORE than 30 minutes prior to a trip and NO LESS than 15 minutes. All participants MUST be on the bus no less than 5 minutes prior to departure. If you are late, the bus will leave you behind and there will be no refund for the trip.
- ◆ Participants can save ONE additional seat for another participant. The seat you select is your seat for the entire trip. You must follow all instructions given by the bus driver such as asking to relocate or share seats. Those that fail to do so may not be permitted on future trips for up to six months.
- ◆ Participants are not permitted to meet us at the trip location and all participants that ride to a location must return on the bus.
- ◆ Participants taking trips during Baca Center business hours, are asked to park in the lower level of the garage or Centennial Plaza parking lot. If able, please leave the handicap spaces for members attending the Center.
- ◆ Only those registered for a trip can participate. There are NO last minute registrations and NO substitutions on the day of the trip.
- ◆ Times and events are subject to change. Return time is an estimated time of return, depending on traffic, event wrap up, and any travel delays. When appropriate, the bus may be available to board and wait until the entire group has returned to the bus at the designated time. **This does not mean the trip will be returning early.**
- ◆ Those that return to the bus more than 10 minutes late to the designated meeting time may not be permitted on future trips for up to six months.
- ◆ Cost for meals will vary by type of restaurant. Participants are responsible for checking meal costs ahead of time through restaurant/venue website. An 8-25% gratuity may be charged.
- ◆ Snacks/drinks are permitted on the bus. For long trips, we may only stop for lunch, so bring food for later. The bus stops every 1.5 hours for a restroom break provided the trip is longer than 2 hours away.
- ◆ Please be sure to double check for your items when leaving the bus and please dispose of your trash.
- ◆ Call the Baca Center for lost and found items left on the bus.

TRIP CANCELLATION POLICY

- In the event of a cancellation by the Baca Center, participants will receive a full refund to their original payment method or a credit to their Parks and Recreation account.
- Cancellations initiated by the participant will be processed as follows:
 - A credit will be issued to the participant's Parks and Recreation Department account if the space can be filled from the waiting list.
 - A) If no substitution can be made and the request is made 14 calendar days or less from the start date of the trip, all fees are forfeited.
 - B) If no substitution can be made and the request is made 14 calendar days or more from the start date of the trip, a credit for the amount of the trip will be applied to your account or you will be assessed a
