

A tax rate of \$0.372000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Round Rock. This rate exceeds the lower of the no- new-revenue rate or voter-approval rate, and state law requires that a public hearing be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

The **no-new-revenue tax rate** is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the City of Round Rock from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The **voter-approval tax rate** is the highest tax rate that the City of Round Rock may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The **proposed tax rate** is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that the City of Round Rock is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

The **proposed tax rate** is not greater than the voter approval tax rate. As a result, the City of Round Rock is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting members of City Council of the City of Round Rock at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Legislature modified the manner in which the voter approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Round Rock last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by the City of Round Rock this year.

| | 2024 | 2025 | Change |
|-------------------------------------|--------------|--------------|----------------------------------|
| Total Tax Rate (per \$100 of value) | \$0.360000 | \$0.372000 | 3.33% increase |
| Average Homestead Taxable Value | \$432,619 | \$460,888 | 6.53% increase |
| Tax on Average Homestead | \$1,557 | \$1,714 | 10.08% increase or \$157 |
| Total tax levy on all properties | \$91,007,424 | \$99,272,594 | 9.08% increase or \$8,265,170 |
