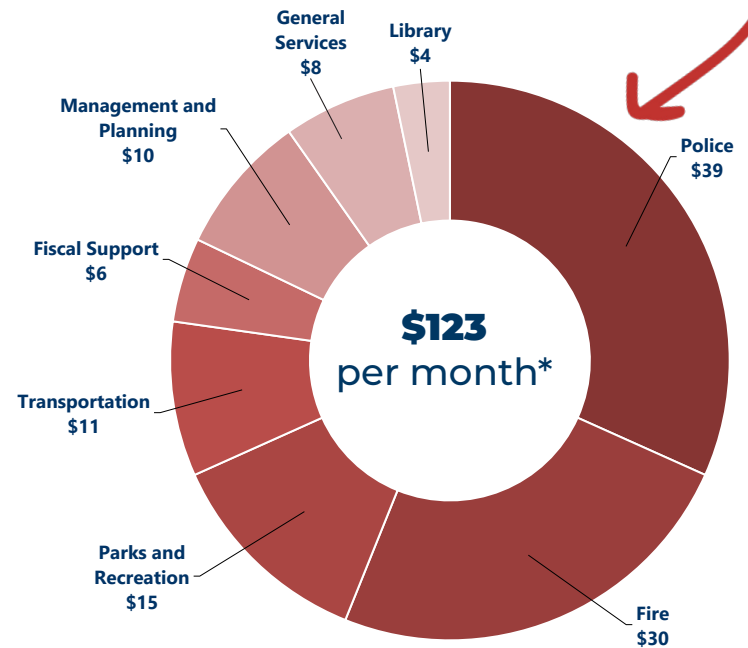
PROPOSED TAX RATE

The proposed tax rate represents a 2.4 cent, or 6.9%, increase above the no new revenue rate. This adjustment will support the addition of **17 new Public Safety positions** and provide funding for projects approved in the **2023 Bond Election**.

SALES TAX REVENUES

Part of the 2% local option sales tax includes a half-cent that **directly reduces property taxes**.

For Fiscal Year 2026, this half-cent reduction translates to a **savings of 11.8 cents** on the property tax rate, saving the median homeowner approximately **\$39 per month, or 24% off** the City's share of their monthly tax bill.



* Based off the median taxable home value in Round Rock. The City is just one of many tax rates applied to each property and is nearly 20% of your total tax bill.

PROPERTY TAX BASE

With a vibrant economy, Round Rock continues to see a broad range of development citywide. Despite 92% of properties being single-family residential, nearly half of property tax revenue is expected from commercial taxpayers.
