## THE LAKE CREEK TRAIL IS NOW OPEN!



This 10-foot-wide multi-use path connects Downtown to Round Rock West, extending from Round Rock West Drive to Centennial Plaza and the Baca Center.

This one mile section of trail winds along Lake Creek.

Minor work remains in the I-35 area to complete full connectivity.
