## Welcome to the new Newsletter for Commercial, Multifamily, Industrial, & Institutional Round Rock Water Customers

**Hello!** You've been sent this newsletter, as City Conservation staff has had contact with you over the last year in some capacity (*leak notifications, irrigation inspections, etc.*). This newsletter will be water utility specific, delivered quarterly and, ideally, useful to you.



### Smart Irrigation Rebate

The city wants to prevent water waste from irrigation system leaks. One way this can be accomplished is to have a master valve installed on the irrigation system mainline.

In the event of a leak within the system, a master valve will prevent the water from running continuously, saving water and keeping utility bills low.

The Smart Irrigation CII Rebate offers up to \$800 for the installation of a master valve! See program details at the link below.

Property Ends in	Water Days
0 or 3	Monday / Thursday
1, 5, or 9	Wednesday / Saturday
2, 6 or 7	Tuesday / Friday
4 or 8	Sunday / Thursday

Watering must occur **before 10 a.m.** or **after 7 p.m.**

### Year Round Water Use Rules

Reminder that Round Rock's outdoor watering schedule is in effect year-round. If irrigation is going to occur, it can't be more than two days per week.

The schedule applies to all properties that receive water from the City, except those using rainwater, reuse or recycled water, or using a private well.

No irrigation is permitted between 10am and 7pm on any day. Drip irrigation is not exempt from these rules.

Properties installing new landscaping can apply for a variance, in order to water more frequently during establishment.
