



## Water Conservation Program CII Smart Irrigation Rebate Guidelines

Water waste is prevalent at commercial, institutional, and industrial sites, often because occupants working at the property are disconnected from outdoor maintenance. This rebate's intent is to reduce waste from on-going water leaks that are not seen or reported, and water waste from inefficiencies in parking lots and small median areas.

### PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a direct City of Round Rock water customer, in good standing.
- Applicant must have an existing irrigation system.
- Pre-inspections will be scheduled on a case-by-case basis.
- An itemized receipt(s) must be submitted with the application within 90-days of installation. Receipt(s) must include date, irrigation company or vendor name and address, amount paid, and description of work.
- Per State law, only the property owner or a licensed irrigator may make irrigation system repairs. A list of licensed irrigators can be found on the [TCEQ Licensing Information](#) page.
- The City does not endorse specific brands or irrigators.
- You will be contacted for a final inspection.

### REBATE DETAILS:

- Rebate amount is a flat amount of \$200 per zone capped or converted to drip irrigation.
- Rebate is 50% of the cost of the device and installation of a master valve or flow meter on the irrigation mainline.
- Maximum total rebate amount is \$1000 per water account per fiscal year. Applicant may apply multiple times a year until maximum amount is reached. Rebate does not apply to the sales tax or any delivery fees.
- Rebates are available until funds have been expended. Visit [roundrocktexas.gov/rebates](http://roundrocktexas.gov/rebates) for rebate status.
- A rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after the application has been processed and final inspection completed.

### RETROFIT DETAILS:

- Conversion of zone to drip = conversion of an entire zone that is **currently** irrigated by above ground irrigation. Drip system must have appropriate pressure regulation, filter, and pressure release valve. *Not applicable to newly added drip zone in an area that was not previously irrigated.*
- Capping or removing an entire zone = the removal or capping of **all** visible heads and/or the removal of zone valves in a zone.
- Flow meter = installing a water flow meter on the main irrigation line will alert management in real-time of unusual water flow or potential leaks in the system; addressing it quickly helps save water and keep bills low.
- Master Valve = installing a master valve on the main irrigation line to prevent water from running continuously in the event of a leak.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

1. Read the Program Guidelines to ensure eligibility.
2. Submit application, picture of rain sensor and receipts within 90-days of installation.
3. Pre- and post-inspections will occur on a case by case basis.
4. Rebate check will be mailed 2-4 weeks after final inspection and application is approved.
