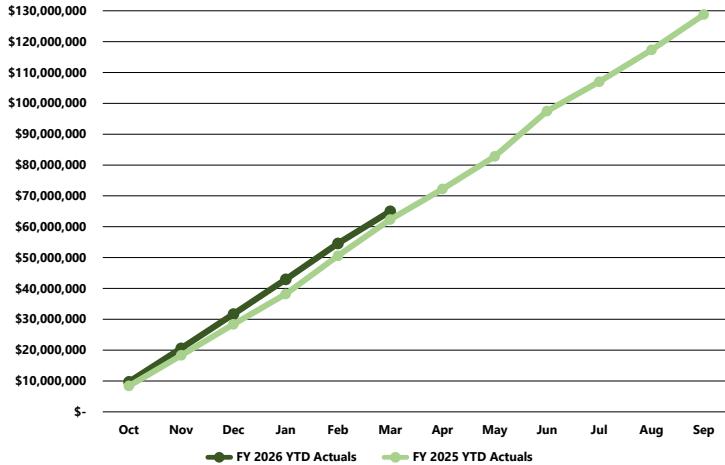


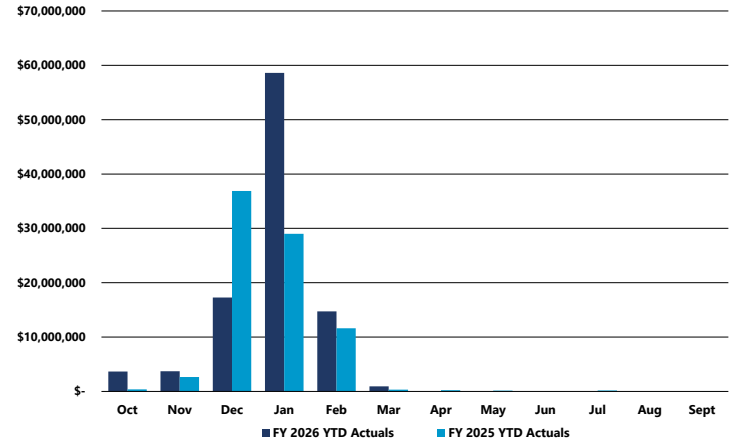

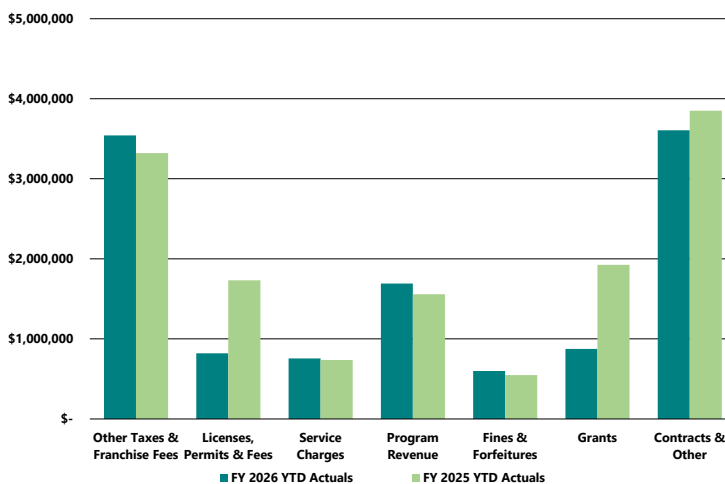
Citywide Sales Tax



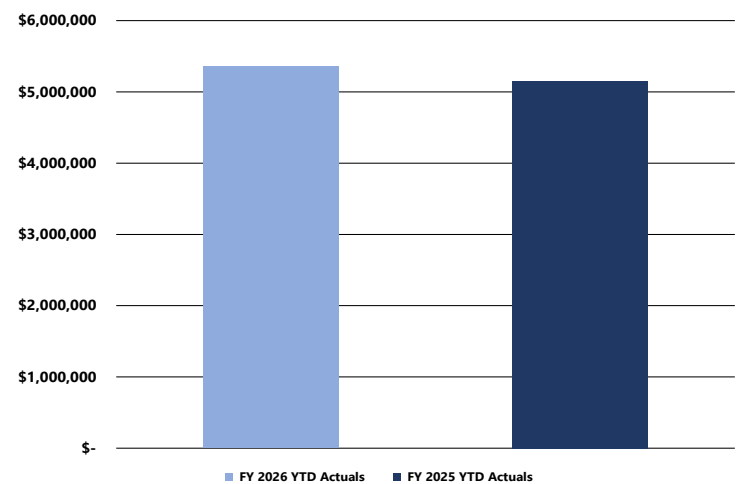
Property Tax

Hotel Occupancy & Venue Tax



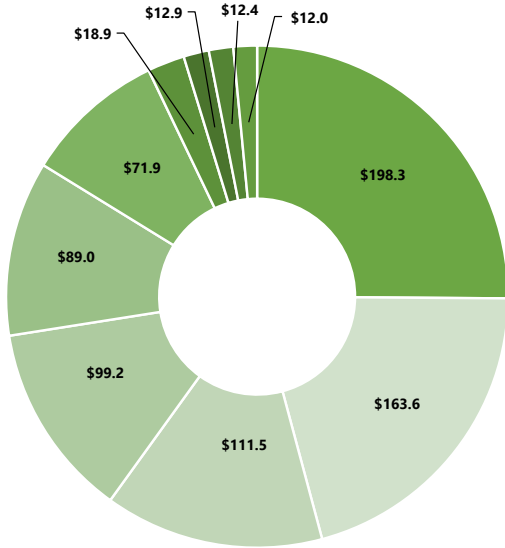
Notes & Comments

- **Sales Tax** collections through the second quarter have increased 4.2% over prior year and Dell has increased 6.8%.
- **Property Tax** collections are higher than prior year due to the higher tax rate for FY 2026 and new properties added.
- **Other Taxes & Franchise Fees** have increased 6.6% due to gas franchise fees.
- **Licenses, Permits, and Fees** have decreased 52.7% due to building permits, building reinspections, fire inspection fees, and subdivision development fees.
- **Program Revenue** has increased 8.5% due to recreation programs, sports league fees, and facility rentals.
- **Fines & Forfeitures** have increased 9.2% due to outstanding court fine collections.
- **Grants** have decreased 54.5% due to deployment reimbursements and the final ARPA payment in the prior fiscal year.
- **Contracts & Other** has decreased 6.4% due to interest income and insurance proceeds.
- **Hotel Occupancy Tax** revenues through the second quarter are up 4.0%.
 - The majority of Kalahari HOT tax revenues (7%) are used to pay debt and incentives per the agreement. Venue tax revenues (2%) from Kalahari are not part of the incentive agreement and stay in the Sports Center Fund.
- **Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater** revenues are trending above prior year due to adopted rate increases effective November 2025. This is the second of three approved increases.

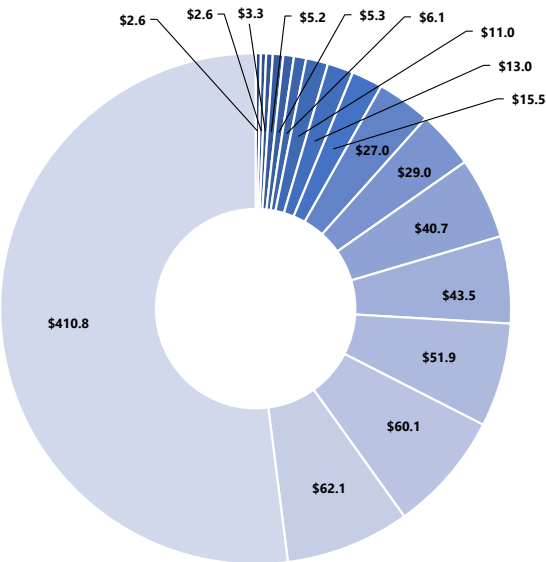
